There are quite a few parking spots near the river. However, in case the lot is full, additional parking is available on the western end of the Point of Rocks MARC train station (A walking path is adjacent to the train tracks to the wooden bridge to where we are meeting.) We will meet on the south side of the wooden bridge. We will be walking east on the canal path. In case you have never been to the canal, the canal path is mostly shaded and is a nice level walk for the dogs.

While there are many opportunities for your Berner to potty, there is only one opportunity for humans at the camp site we will pass.

After the walk, we will return to the parking area for lunch. Bring a bag lunch. Drinks will be provided. I will also have water/bowls available for dogs. Please bring a folding chair as Point of Rocks does not have picnic tables. (I will bring a table.)

Directions:

From MD : RT 15 South to Rt 28.
Turn Left onto Rt 28. Take an immediate right onto Commerce Street. Follow Commerce Street down and across the wooden bridge to the parking lot.

From VA: Take Rt 15 North into MD.
The first turn on Right is Rt 28.
Follow other directions above.
