~100.5-102.5° Normal

Signs of Heat Stroke

- Heavy panting
- Difficulty breathing
 - Excessive thirst
- Lethargy & unsteadiness
- Thick saliva and drooling
- · Vomiting and/or diarrhea
- Bright red tongue and mucus membrances, which turn grey as shock sets in

Heat Stroke can occur in less than 15 minutes! If signs are visible... often times it may be too late!
